



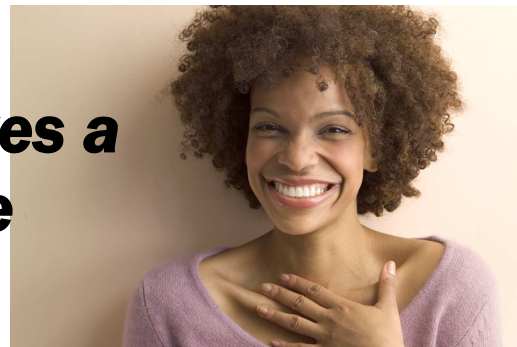
Temporary ID Card
